



What is METRORapid?


- A bus rapid transit (BRT) system that provides fast and reliable high-capacity service – similar to
 METRORail – with dedicated stations and lanes
- METRORapid stations and platforms have the same look as METRORail
- The METRORapid Silver Line demonstrates the type of service that METRO will provide with this project





University Corridor Project

- 25.3-mile METRORapid Line
- More than 40 stations
- Dedicated bus lanes
- New and renovated transit centers
- New bus operating facilities
- First-mile/last-mileconnections
- Operates mostly in METRO-owned Right of Way (ROW) in Segment 1
- Operates on City of
 Houston streets throughout
 Segments 2 5





Why METRORapid University Corridor Project?

- More transit service to accommodate growth and density

- Respond to existing and future development in the corridor

- Provides 100% accessibility with wider doors and level boarding






How does METRORapid benefit my community?








Proposed TSU Wheeler Station Rendering









Proposed University of Houston HAWK Crossing on Elgin Street Rendering








Proposed University of Houston Entrance 18 Station Rendering













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Segment 5 University Corridor






