

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY – February 2025

Calendar Mix. There was one fewer weekday in February 2025 compared to February 2024 due to leap year occurring in 2024. METRO would have expected a negative impact to ridership in February 2025 relative to February 2024 due to calendar mix.

Calendar Mix – Holidays. There were no observed holidays February 2025 and February 2024. Although President’s Day occurred in both February 2025 and February 2024, METRO offered regular weekday service for February 2025 and February 2024. As a result, METRO would have expected a neutral impact to ridership in February 2025 relative to February 2024 due to holidays.

Weather. There was four weather days in February 2025 compared to one weather day in February 2024. As a result, METRO would have expected a negative impact to ridership in February 2025 relative to February 2024 due to weather.

Service Disruption. There were two scheduled service interruption days in February 2025 compared to no scheduled service interruption days in February 2024. METRO would have expected a negative impact to ridership in February 2025 compared to February 2024 as a result of service disruptions.

Special Events. There were two days of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo and two Monster Jam event in February 2025 compared six days of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo and one Monster Jam event in February 2024. METRO would have expected a negative impact to ridership as a result.

Service Levels. There were more revenue hours of service on both local and Park and Ride services in February 2025 than in February 2024. With more revenue hours of service, METRO would have expected a positive impact to ridership in February 2025 relative to February 2024.
